Founded in 1919, the Kiwanis Club of Asheville has worked to improve the lives of children, and those in need, in our community through hundreds of projects and partnerships throughout Western North Carolina.

Outdoor Experiences

The Kiwanis Club partners with local shelters and school social workers to identify children and families who might benefit from "experiences" around Asheville. The past 2 years we have invited over 60 children and their caregivers to the Nature Center for a personal guided group tour and Chic-Fil-A lunch. We also took mothers and children from Transformation Village to see the lights at the Arboretum at Christmas. With these events the Kiwanis Club of Asheville hopes to provide a memorable outdoor experience for children, fostering their connection with nature and encouraging their personal growth.

Kiwanis Adopt a School Program



For the past four years we have adopted Johnston Elementary, a low income school in the county. We provide funding for items the school may need for the students and teachers, help with teacher appreciation, special events and reward programs such as a dance party, bowling, movies, big toy day and more. There are also many volunteer opportunities from helping in a classroom, helping sort books in the library to weeding their school garden.

Bike Giveaway



We give Johnston Elementary School 1 bike each nine weeks to use as an attendance incentive. We have also given 1 bike to Jones Elementary in the past for perfect attendance. In 2020-21, Kiwanis received a \$500 grant from New Belgium which helped us reach even more children in the community. We also recently received a grant of 100 helmets from NCDOT which were given to all 3rd and 4th graders at Johnston after they completed a bicycle safety class.

Key Club Scholarships



College scholarships are given out to high school students who are actively serving in one of our three Key Clubs at Enka, Reynolds and Erwin High School. We factor in hours of service with both Key Club and the Kiwanis Club as well as general academic achievements. We support inspiring students to learn the importance of service in our community and help them embrace opportunities for leadership in their schools.

Sleep Tight Kids



Our club gave Transformation Village a total of \$85,000 which has helped to double the beds for women and children, and also built a playground for preschool children. We also provide and serve dinner to the women and children at the shelter once a quarter.
